

### **1 - Jesus sees and talks with a single woman – us too!**

**John 4:7** When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?"

**Rev 3:20** Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.

### **2 - Jesus offers her living water and eternal life – us too!**

**John 4:13-15** Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life." The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water so that I won't get thirsty and have to keep coming here to draw water."

**Rev 22:17** The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.

### **3 - Jesus saw and knew about all her broken relationships – and ours!**

**John 4:16-18** [Jesus] told her, "Go, call your husband and come back." "I have no husband," she replied. Jesus said to her, "You are right when you say you have no husband. The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband. What you have just said is quite true."

**Ps 56:8** You keep track of all my sorrows. You have collected all my tears in your bottle. You have recorded each one in your book.

### **4 - Jesus saw and knew about all her spiritual confusion – and ours!**

**John 4:22-23** You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, for salvation is from the Jews. Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.

### **5 - Jesus saw and knew who she could reach for God's glory with her story – us too!**

**John 4:28,39** The woman went back to the town and said to the people, "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did... Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony."
