Discussion Questions:

In the story of Elliot Ness and how he kept his integrity - Consider yourself in that situation, you not only were offered a lot of money but also your life so to speak. What do you think you would have done? What would have been the hardest part of taking a stand because of your integrity?

I think we've all been tempted in many different ways yet God calls us to be Men and Women of Legend – known for our integrity. People who can't be bought, People who stand for righteousness in a land that is filled with evil and corruption. What is the hardest part of that for you personally? Or if it's easy, share what you have done to make that easy for yourself.

God calls us to make a choice: Decide what kind of people we want to be: Take out the "right" thing to say here and be honest. What kind of a person are you? What kind of person do you want to be? How can this group help you in succeeding in being different? What kind of accountability do you personally want?

Regarding the survey that was done in 2008 People were to evaluate what they thought about 8 specific activities: Watching pornography, Using profanity in public, Gambling, Gossiping, Engaging in sexual intercourse with someone to whom they were not married, Seeking revenge against someone, Getting drunk and Lying. Considering the people you "hang out with more" this could be co-workers; friends; church fellowship how do you think these things are viewed today in 2015?

Those who choose Wickedness verses those who choose Righteousness we have specific verses that we can read that tells us the blessings we would get if we choose Righteousness. Why do you think it's so difficult for people to choose Righteousness and accept the blessings God wants to give us?
