Man's advice may or may not be good. It depends on where the man has derived his wisdom. The wisdom of God will give one the ability to make an eternally significant impact with your life.

#### **Discussion Questions:**

Have you ever read through the entire book of Proverbs? If so, how has this been valuable to you in your walk with Christ? If not, how do you think you could benefit from reading this book in the Bible?

People with wisdom have the skill to face life honestly and courageously and manage it successfully so that God's purposes are fulfilled in their life. Where do you think you've been lacking in wisdom? What would you like to see different in your life today?
